

# Implementation date and additional rounds 2015

## Tobacco products package coverage and location

Graphic health warnings are required to cover the top 70% of the front and 70% of the back of the package. Overall, 70% of the package space is allocated to health warnings.

### Misleading information

Misleading descriptors such as 'low in tar,' 'light,' 'ultralight,' 'mild,' 'high-end' and 'low-end' are prohibited from appearing on packages.

#### **Constituents and emissions information**

No messages are required to display qualitative (descriptive) constituents and emissions information.

### Special notes

Legislation applies to all tobacco products (combusted and smokeless) without specifying the content of the warnings for each type of tobacco.

# Rotation schedule, history, language, and help for smoking cessation

Chad has produced one round of graphic health warning labels:

Round (year)	Number	Size (%) [average— front/back]
R1 (2015)	4	70 — 70/70

Warnings within the round are required to be rotated for a period of 2 years. Warning texts must be in French and Arabic, the principal languages of the country. No quitline phone number or government-sponsored website is required to be displayed on the package.
