#### Package coverage

Health warnings are required to cover 50% the front and 50% of the back of the package. Overall, 50% of the package space is appropriated to health warnings. The text of the warnings appears in Arabic on the front of the package and English on the back.

#### **Rotation schedule and history**

Six warnings are used on tobacco packages. Two warnings are specifically meant for waterpipe tobacco packages.

#### Restrictions on misleading information


Misleading descriptors such as "light" and "mild" are prohibited from appearing on packages.


